After purchasing our Spencer facility, we began a capital campaign to renovate the new Spencer campus and update the existing Spirit Lake campus. We are on track to hit our \$800,000 campaign goal in one year! The renovation work on the Spencer Campus is making great progress. Thanks to the work of many dedicated volunteers and our contractors, we expect to be in the facility before the New Year.

We have focused on being a church that gives to our community. At Christmas time, we took a special offering for the ATLAS ministries in the Spencer and Lakes areas to help them better serve those facing financial and life hardships.

We celebrated baptisms at the lake and a joint worship service in the Roof Garden in Arnold's Park.

We love to keep our finger in the text. We spent most of this year in a study of 1 Samuel. Over the summer we taught a sermon series called, "What does the Bible say?" We answered people's questions on what the Bible says about: Angels, Demons, Forgiveness, Death, The Lord's Super, Transgenderism, and Sin.

As a church family, we are involved in a Take-Up-And-Read Bible reading plan to help keep us in God's Word
