Read 1 Timothy 1:16. How does Paul's conversion and subsequent life provide you hope? How does it provide hope for sharing the good news of Jesus with people far from God?

Read 1 Timothy 1:13. Why was it important for Paul to point out that he received mercy when he was ignorant of Christ? How does this change the way you think about living the Christian life?

Read 1 Timothy 1:18-20. What was it that Hymanaeus and Alexander did and how did it affect their faith in Christ? How is this a warning to us about willful sin?
