## Part 1 - Ice Breaker

## Part 2 - Sermon Review

- 1. What are the two main lessons in the book of Daniel?
- 2. This was not the first time God appeared to be conquered by a foreign deity. Read 1 Samuel 5:1-7. What do we learn from it?
- 3. Read Daniel 1:1-2. Why did Nebuchadnezzar rob Jerusalem's temple?
- 4. Read Daniel 1:3-8. How would most teenage boys respond to this kind of royal treatment?
- 5. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12; Colossians 3:1-11. Where are we to draw the line in questionable, culturally accepted activities?
- 6. Read Colossians 3:12-17. Using your own words, what are the six principles presented by Paul to help us live for God on a daily basis?
- 7. What was the three pronged attack Nebuchadnezzar used to transform young men into his willing servants? Where do you see Satan using the same strategies today against Christians?
- 8. What are common compromises made by Christians that suffocate God's blessing on their life?
- 9. What is a *risk of obedience*? What *risks of obedience* have you taken?
- 10. While God honors those who honor him, does that guarantee all *risks of obedience* will work out for God's immediate blessing (Read Daniel 3:17-18)?
