- 5. Read Daniel 2:10-11;27-28. What is significant about Nebuchadnezzar's demand for magicians and enchanters to tell him his dream, not just interpret it?
- 6. Read Daniel 2:31-45. What world kingdoms do the differing parts of the statue represent?
- 7. Read Daniel 2:44-45. How does the stone not cut out with human hands connect with Christmas?
- 8. While it sounds like Nebuchadnezzar had a genuine conversion, what evidence is there that it wasn't (Read Daniel 3:1-7)
- 9. Since God has my life in complete control, how does that change the way I handle the stress of the Christmas season (Read Luke 12:22-31)?
- 10. How does Daniel 2 change the way I feel about the problems I hear on the evening news?
