## 1. Pray for an understanding of God's love that is more than I can humanly <u>comprehend</u>.

that according to the riches of his glory he may grant <u>you to be strengthened</u> with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <u>may</u> have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, Ephesians 3:16–18 (ESV)

## 2. Pray for greater understanding of the love of God than the <u>knowledge</u> of God.

and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. Ephesians 3:19 (ESV)

3. Pray for a better understanding of God's power toward me that is greater than I can <u>ask</u> or <u>imagine</u>.

Now to him <u>who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think.</u> <u>according to the power at work within us</u>, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen. Ephesians 3:20–21 (ESV)
