of John was written help us understand the importance of Jesus' statement in John 2 when he says, "tear this temple down and I will rebuild it in three days?"

- 3. When John the Baptist lost market share to Jesus, his first thought was to rest in God's sovereignty. What is God's sovereignty? How does knowing God loves me and nothing is out of his control change the way I feel when in a difficult season of life?
